

Washing Machine Usage & Maintenance tips



Selection of right location

- Avoid direct sun light, Humid place & heat generating area or exposed to rain
- Set the washer on a dry, levelled floor in a well ventilated area.
- Allow 5cm. Space from all the side of washer.
- Level the washer with help of front two adjusting legs to eliminate vibrations.



Selection of right electric connection.

- An exclusive 3 pin 5A wall socket with fuse having 1 ph., 220-240 volts, 50 Hz.,
- Phase on right hand side proper earthling.



Proper fitment of inlet & outlet connection

- Water supply pressure to be with 0.3 10 kg/cm².
- Maximum 2-meter extension of water inlet & outlet (drain) hose allowed.
- Change the outlet drainpipe position according to customer requirement.



Preparation before washing

- Sort the cloth.
- Remove pins, coins, keys etc.
- Turn the cloth inside out.
- Put the delicate & small cloth inside the netted basket.
- Select required amount of water as per cloth load.
- Put required amount of detergent.



Wash & Soak selection procedure

- Select soak as per requirement...
- Select cycle setting as per type of fabric & load.
- Select wash timing as per recommended in user manual.(in case of Sammie auto.)



Rinsing procedure

 Perform spin shower rinsing, over flow rinsing or fix amount of rinsing after completing wash to remove total soap from the clothes.

Complete spin procedure

- Incise of Sammie auto transfer the cloth in spin basket fix the spin cap.
- Select the spin cycle setting according to type of fabric.



Ending the process

- Drain the water completely from the drainpipe.
- Then hang the drainage hose.
- Switches off the main power supply and unplug the power cord



Maintenance

- Clean wash tub
- Clean Overflow outlet
- Clean lint filter

Tips for Improving Wash Quality



Given bellow are few tips that will help you get better results from your washing machine, as well as keep the clothes & washing machine in good condition for a long time.

- Pre-Rinse the clothes before main wash in plain water, as 60% of spoilage can be dissolved. Hence the detergent will be more effective on removing the balance soilage.
- Do not overload the washer.
- Select appropriate water level as per the load so that clothes can freely move around in the detergent water resulting in a good wash.
- Sort your clothes before wash
- Wash whites separately from colors.

Tips for Improving Wash Quality



- Wash less soiled cloths separately from heavily soiled.
- Separate lint givers from lint takers.
- Make sure that all pockets are empty of coins, pins etc.
- Turn garments made of lint taker fabric inside out before washing.
- Do not allow wet clothes to remain in the washer for long period.
- Clean the lint filter regularly
- Wipe your washer clean after every wash.
- Keep washer's lid open for some time after the wash to avoid smell & fungus.
